We have several fundraisers scheduled this fall to assist our dance company and to assist you with payment for your dance season. Covid has taken a toll on us financially so please consider participating in the fundraisers.

General Guidelines:

1. Profit from sales will be split 60/40. That is, 40% of your sales profits will go to LPDC general funds and 60% will be placed into an individual fundraising account for you to use throughout the year for any dance related expenses. Total profit is calculated once all expenses are paid including any taxes or delivery fees.
2. Remember that is based on the profit amount, not your sales total.
3. For all fundraisers, full payment is due when the order is placed.
4. There are no refunds on fundraiser orders.
5. Please fill out all forms completely including totals.
6. We are not responsible for wrong orders for forms that were not legible or tallied incorrectly so please be clear.
7. For fundraisers that are delivered. You will be required to sign off that your order is complete before leaving. Please make sure everything is correct because once you leave the building with your order, all orders are considered final and there are no replacements, exchanges or add-ons.
8. For group orders, please submit cash, or only one check or money order for payment. We will not take any checks from people outside of LPDC.
9. There is a \$30 fee for any returned checks.
10. Anytime you wish to use funds from your fundraising account, please fill out a Fundraiser Withdrawal Form which can be found on our website. From the main page, click on Class Info and then select Studio Documents.
11. If you quit dance before the year is up, your fundraising account will be forfeited to the LPDC general fund. It is illegal to fundraise for a group or particular cause and then give someone a personal check for those funds to use in a different manner. The funds must be used through LPDC for dance related expenses.
12. Dance related expenses could include tuition fees, costume fees, recital tickets, pictures, competition fees or anything dance related through LPDC.
13. Any unused funds for students who completed the season, will be rolled over to the following year. However, if you are not registered for classes by Nov. 1st of the following dance season, your funds will be forfeited to the LPDC general fund.
14. If you owe any fees by the end of the season and you still have funds in your fundraising account, the unpaid fees will be automatically deducted from your fundraising account to pay toward your final balance.
15. Any restaurant fundraisers such as "Dining to Donate" will be designated to the LPDC general funds only.
